FLORIDA JUNIOR GRADE CATTLE IDENTITY PROGRAM

This program is intended for 4-H and FFA project dairy animals not eligible for registry or enrollment in one of the dairy breed association identity programs. Animals that meet requirements should be identified through respective national breed association programs.

PROCEDURE

1. Fill out form on reverse side.
2. Attach photographs (All Breeds).
3. Get verification from County Extension Agent or FFA Advisor
4. Send to: Chris Holcomb, PO Box 9005, Drawer HS03, Bartow, FL 33831. Photographs can also be e-mailed to christophersholc@ufl.edu (preferred method).
5. To record ownership change, submit FJGDC Identity Certificate along with new application.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Positive Identity
 - Ayrshire
 - Guernsey
 - Holstein} Photograph of both sides (tattoo in one ear or both ears suggested)
- Brown Swiss
- Jersey
} Photograph of both sides, Tattoo in one or both ears required2. Date of birth
3. Breed – only animals unquestionably characteristic of Ayrshire, Brown Swiss, Guernsey, Holstein or Jersey Breeds are eligible.
CROSSBREEDS NOT ELIGIBLE!
4. Purchased from: The name of farm (or owner) from which the animal was obtained. If born on applicant's farm, indicate, "born on my farm".
5. Date of Purchase
6. Signature of applicant (owner).
7. Signature of seller/breeder.
8. Signature of County Extension Agent or FFA Advisor.
9. Photographs: 2 photographs, one of each side are required for all breeds. Digital Photos are preferred and can be emailed to christophersholc@ufl.edu If digital images not available photographs must be no larger than 4" x 6" and not Polaroid.
10. Only 4-H and FFA members in Florida are eligible as applicants.
11. A name should be given to the animal (no more than 10 letters and spaces).
12. Sire and dam should be reported if available but are not required.
13. Application must be submitted within six months of animal's birth date or date of purchase. **All Applications must be postmarked by January 15 of the show year to be valid for the South Florida Fair, State 4-H Dairy Show and Florida State Fair.**
