YOUTH LIVESTOCK SHOW ETHICS AND ANIMAL CARE WORKSHOP

**PLEASE NOTE: Attendance will qualify for certification but
NOT for Achievement Points**

The Florida State Fair believes that every youth exhibitor should receive proper training and information for raising and showing a youth animal project. It is important that the exhibitors understand:

- The purpose of youth livestock projects
- The importance of ethics in youth livestock projects
- Proper animal handling and management
- The difference between animal welfare and animals rights
- Be prepared to be an ambassador for animal agriculture

The Youth Livestock Show Ethics and Animal Care Workshop is designed to certify students to meet the mandatory certification requirements that will be in effect for the 2011 Florida State Fair. Certification is valid for a three (3) year period.

The requirements are as follows:

- All students that were entered in the Florida State Fair from 2006 to 2010 must have completed the Ethics training to show an animal at the 2011 Florida State Fair.
- YOUTH EXHIBITING AT OTHER FLORIDA FAIRS SHOULD CHECK THAT SPECIFIC FAIR'S RULES FOR ETHICS QUALIFICATIONS.
- **PLEASE NOTE THIS RULE RELATES TO FLORIDA STATE FAIR EXHIBITORS ONLY:** Youth that are exhibiting for the first time at the 2011 Florida State Fair will have a one (1) year grace period to complete the Ethics training.
