## Class Number and Name

1. Fall Heifer Calf born September 1 - November 30, 2009 (animals must be weaned)
2. Summer Heifer Calf, born June 1 - August 31, 2009
3. Spring Heifer Calf born March 1 - May 31, 2009
4. Winter Yearling Heifer born December 1, 2008 - February 28, 2009
5. Fall Yearling Heifer born September 1- November 30, 2008
6. Summer Yearling Heifer born June 1 - August 31, 2008
7. Spring Yearling Heifer born March 1 - May 30, 2008 (any yearling in milk will be shown in two-year old class)
8. JUNIOR CHAMPION
9. RESERVE JUNIOR CHAMPION
10. Junior Two-year-old cow born September 1, 2007 - February 28, 2008
11. Senior Two-year-old cow born March 1, 2007 - August 31, 2007
12. Three-year-old cow born March 1, 2006 - February 28, 2007
13. Four-year-old cow born March 1, 2005 - February 28, 2006
14. Five-year-old cow born March 1, 2004 - February 28, 2005
15. Aged cow born before March 1, 2004
16. Dry Cow Class - any animal born before September 1, 2007 that has had one or more lactations and is currently dry.
17. SENIOR CHAMPION
18. RESERVE SENIOR CHAMPION
19. GRAND CHAMPION
20. RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION
21. Dairy Herd, four cows, all that have freshened. All are to be owned by exhibitor limited to one entry
22. Best three females, any age, all are to have been bred by and at least one animal currently owned by exhibitor. Each exhibitor limited to one entry.
23. Get-of-Sire, four animals, the get of one sire, any age. Sire must be named. Animals may be owned by one or more exhibitor.
24. Produce-of-Dam, two animals any age the produce of one cow. Animals need not be owned by one exhibitor.
25. Daughter-Dam, 2 animals, dam and daughter, any age. Animals need not be owned by one exhibitor.
26. Breeders Herd, five females, all owned by the exhibitor, consists of two females over two years of age, two females uncalved under two years of age and one of any age. Three must be bred by the exhibitor.
27. Best Udder Awards, prior to final placing of cows in classes 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15.  
The judge will select the first and second best uddered cows in each of these classes. Selection will be made on the basis of udder alone with milkout left to the discretion of the judge. Class winners will not compete against each other for best uddered cow of the show.
